

Sundays in the Park

Dunn State Park

Come to Dunn State Park on Sundays at 1pm and join us for the following programs.

First Sunday of each month starting at 1pm, we'd like to invite bluegrass and folk musicians (stressing the acoustic due to space) to come and sit around the fireplace at the Dunn State Park Visitor Center and pick and jam with fellow musicians. Come meet new friends, learn new songs or techniques, and connect with fellow musicians in a beautiful setting while "**Pickin' at Dunn**".

Second Sunday of each month (through April) at 1pm, come join "**The Clique**" and share your photography and experience with fellow photographers. We invite you to bring one or two photographic prints (8x10 or larger) to share with others and tell the story behind the image. Share your experience and expertise with others around the fireplace at Dunn State Park Visitor Center and then venture out on the trails to capture new images. Snap.

Third Sunday of each month (through April) at 1pm, join us in the warmth of the Dunn State Park Visitor Center to share "**Poetry and Prose of the Outdoor World**". Bring poetry or writings of your own or ones with special meaning to you and share them with the group. Tell the story or meaning behind the writing and join in the discussion or just sit back and reflect on each poem or reading beside a crackling fire. Spend time afterwards walking the trails or just writing and looking out over the pond from the comfort of the Visitor Center.

Fourth Sunday of each month (through April) at 1pm, come for "**The Nature of Dunn**" where we will discuss the flora and fauna of Dunn State Park in the comfort of the Visitor Center and then head out for a nature hike around the pond or through the woods tracking the wildlife, looking for sign, or just enjoying the quiet solitude of the woods.
